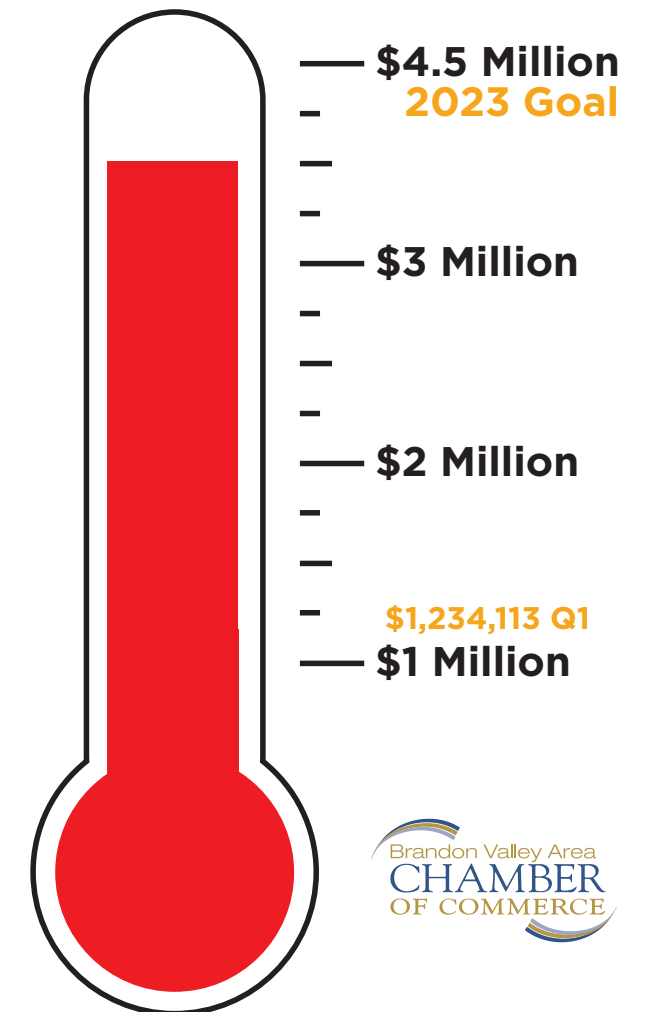

This season, the Chamber wants to remind you of the benefits of shopping at your locally owned Small Businesses! Here's 5 reasons to keep your business in the Brandon & Valley Springs area during the holidays (and all occasions!):

#1: Money you spend locally supports local kids. When you buy your groceries, gifts and experiences from local business owners, they have more money to support your children's activities. From your favorite school team to theatre productions to youth groups, local business sponsors are the ones who help pay for development and growth. Need to sell goodies to raise money for your organization? Your in town retailers are happy to give you space to do it. Need financial sponsors for your child's athletic team tournament? Your local restaurants are happy to kick in some funds.

Remember, the more you financially support local businesses, the more money they have to help you fund your activities.

#2: You get local expertise that national chains won't have. If covid-19 has taught us anything, it's that everyone has a hobby they just needed a push to discover. Whether it's gardening, painting, home improvement projects, or training your new pet, there's a local shop in your community that can give you expert advice on how to reach your goals. Who knows better than someone who



lives in your neighborhood if your yard's soil is the right kind for growing squash? Or if that perfect paint color you picked will need sealer to last under South Dakota storms? Did you know your neighbor works at the local veterinary clinic and has awesome advice on how to keep your dog calm during the Husets fireworks shows? Shop locally, and you can have your own real life "How did you know that?" moment.

With the tax revenue from 2019, the City of Brandon was able to purchase a new plow truck and a loader for improvement projects. You can thank yourself and your tax dollars for the new splash pad and waterslides at the city pool too!

#5: It's good for the environment and inter-business relationships. Local businesses often work together to supply their storefronts. Buying from your area grocery store means buying from your local farmers instead of a commercial farm halfway across the country. Going out to local bars and restaurants means getting drinks supplied by area breweries, wineries and distilleries. All this local commerce means less environmental toll from shipping goods across the country, and it creates positions locally for distribution. Plus -- if it's local, chances are the price is cheaper!

CITY FINANCES PROPERTY TAX & SALES TAX

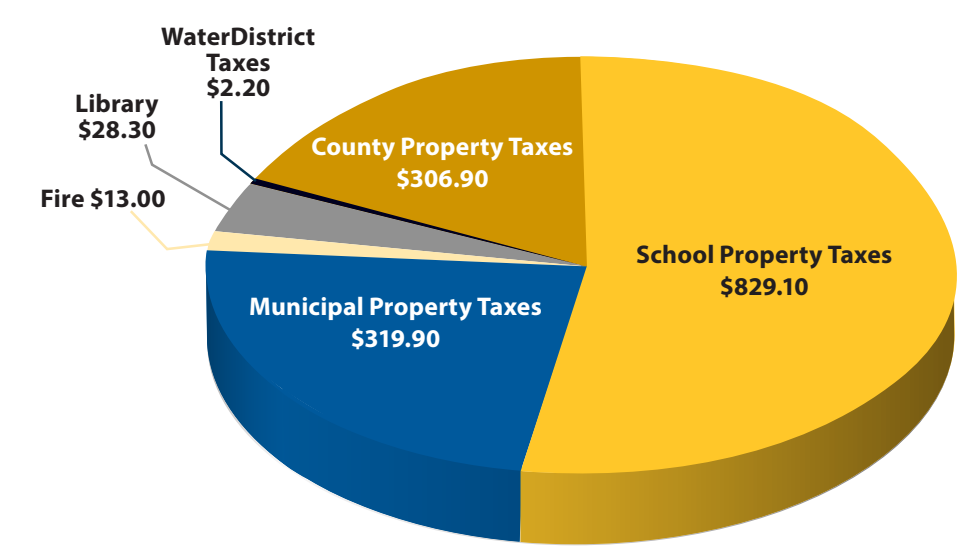
PROPERTY TAXES (OWNER OCCUPIED ONLY)

Property tax is one source of revenue that supports the day to day operations of your City. The Minnehaha County Auditor's Office collects all property taxes and then distributes the taxes to the appropriate entity. The City receives about 21.34% of an owner-occupied residential property tax bill. Property tax revenue is a general fund revenue supporting police, fire, streets, snow removal, parks, pool and more. Property tax is one of the major sources of revenue for any City and without this we could not run your City. A worksheet to figure your taxes is available at www.cityofbrandon.org/taxes. *Please note this does not provide opt outs, Special Assessments or Frontage amounts if applicable.

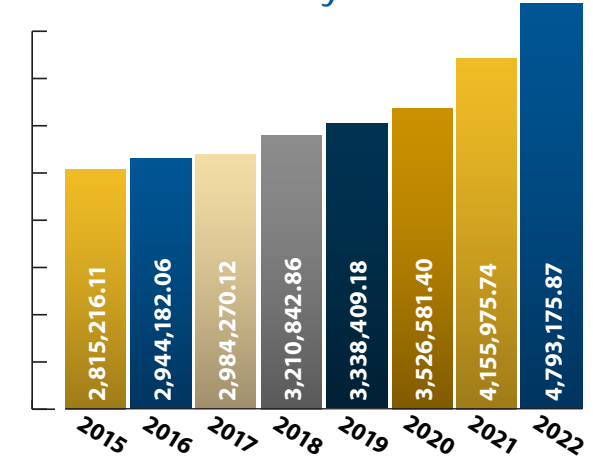
100,000 Taxable Value for Payable 2023



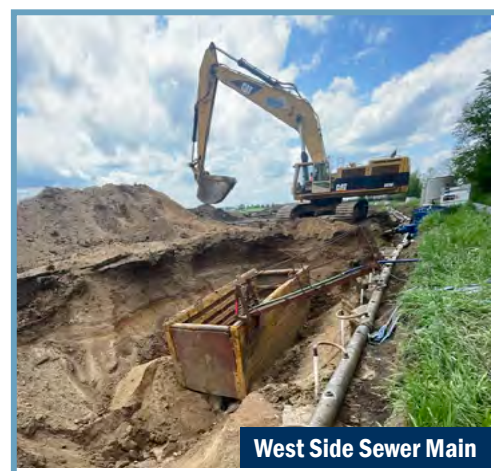
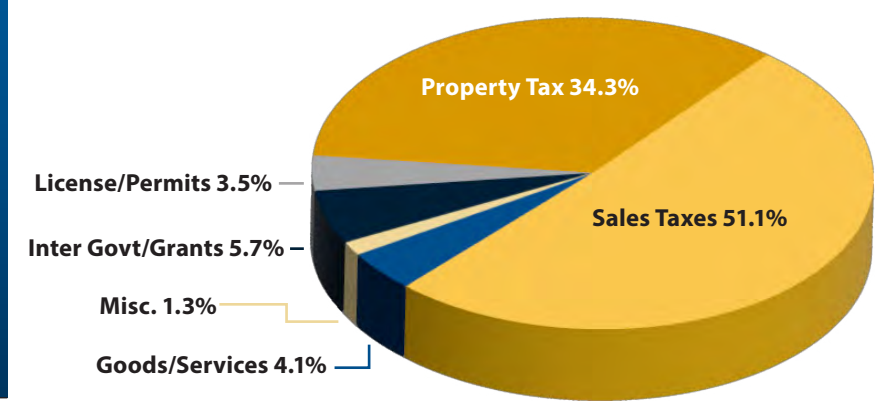
SALES TAX

Sales tax is important to the City and another major source of revenue. This revenue source is not quite as consistent or predictable as property taxes. Sales tax changes with the economy. With every dollar you spend, two cents goes to the City's General Fund. Sales tax revenue is a key component in being able to improve your city. Sales tax pays for debt, projects and equipment in the General Fund.

2022 General Fund Revenues



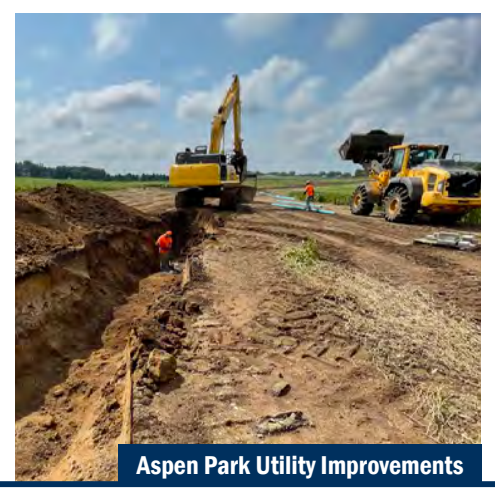

SNOW REMOVAL

DISPOSAL OF SNOW FROM SIDEWALKS

It shall be the duty of the owner or occupant of any lot or parcel of land in the City abutting on any sidewalk to keep such sidewalk free from snow and ice accumulation. Within forty-eight (48) hours after the termination of any snowfall, the snow accumulation shall be removed. Where, however, it is impossible to keep the sidewalk clear due to frozen conditions, then said owner or occupant shall sprinkle or spread some suitable material on

the sidewalk to prevent it from becoming dangerous to travel. If the owner or person in charge of the lot fails or refuses to remove the snow and/or ice from the sidewalks within twenty-four (24) hours after written notice has been posted on the property, the City shall have the snow and/or ice removed and charge the costs thereof against the abutting property the sum established by the resolution of City Council.

DISPOSAL OF SNOW FROM DRIVEWAYS AND PARKING AREAS

It shall be the duty of the property owner, tenant or person in possession of any public or private driveway, parking lot or parking area to dispose of accumulated snow upon such property in such a manner that any snow when removed shall not be deposited upon any sidewalk, within or upon any public street or alley, or in any manner that will obstruct or interfere with the passage or vision of vehicle or pedestrian traffic. It shall be the

duty of the property owner, tenant or person in of any property abutting on any sidewalk to dispose of accumulated snow upon such sidewalk in such a manner that any snow when removed shall not be deposited within or upon any public street or alley, after such public street or alley has been cleared of snow by the grading of such snow away from the curb or the picking up and carrying away of such snow by the City. It shall be the duty of any person who removes snow from any public or private driveway, parking lot or parking area, to dispose of accumulated snow upon the property from which it was removed in such a manner that such snow shall not be deposited upon any sidewalk, within or upon any public street or alley, or in a manner that will obstruct or interfere with the passage or vision of vehicle or pedestrian traffic.

DISPOSAL OF SNOW FROM AROUND MAILBOXES

It is the responsibility of the property owner or occupant in possession of any mailbox located upon a driveway, parking lot or public right-of-way to remove and dispose of accumulated snow from the immediate area around the mailbox so as not to obstruct or interfere with the delivery or collection of the United States mail.

DECLARATION OF SNOW REMOVAL ALERT

A snow alert will occur automatically with the accumulation of three (3) inches of snow on the public streets or when the person designated determines that snow removal from the public streets will commence, that person will announce through local news media and whatever other sources are available that there has been declared a snow removal alert and that the provisions of this chapter will be effective and be enforced, designating a particular date and time when such alert shall commence. The determination to declare a snow removal alert will be based on the then existing weather conditions and the amount of snow then on the ground or expected according to forecasts for the national weather.

PARKING DURING SNOW REMOVAL ALERT IN ALL AREAS OF THE CITY

Parking on any public street of the City will be completely prohibited, on both sides and regardless of the directional run of that street, during the existence of a snow removal alert.

SNOW REMOVAL - FIRE HYDRANTS

In an emergency, every second matters. Fire hydrants that are blocked, concealed or difficult to access due to snow or ice can impede emergency fire response. Fire trucks carry a finite amount of water, so one of the responders' first

tasks upon arriving at a fire is to locate a water supply from the nearest hydrant. Hydrants covered in snow can be difficult to locate, and uncovering them can waste valuable time needed during a fire fight. Keeping them clear can mean easier access to water and more time doing what really matters — fighting the fire.

PEDDLERS AND VENDORS DEFINITIONS

Farmer’s Market: An outdoor market where at least 75% of products sold directly to consumers is local food and agriculturally related products grown or created by canning, baking, preserving, etc.

Peddler: as used in this chapter shall mean any person traveling from place to place, from house to

house to from street to street for the purpose of selling or soliciting for sale good, wares, merchandise or services, other than agricultural products produced or processed in this state; and shall also include any person transacting a temporary business within the City at an established place of business.

Residential Route Sales Person: as used in this chapter shall mean any person who travels from place to place, from house to house, or from street to street for the purpose of selling or soliciting for sale goods, wares, merchandise or services, but who makes stop for sales or delivery routinely, as part of a usual or regular route, and/or by invitation of the resident(s) of the premises visited.

Sidewalk Vendor: as used in this chapter shall mean any person selling or soliciting for sale goods, wares, merchandise or services, from a stationary but temporary or seasonal location, on private or public property with the City of Brandon.

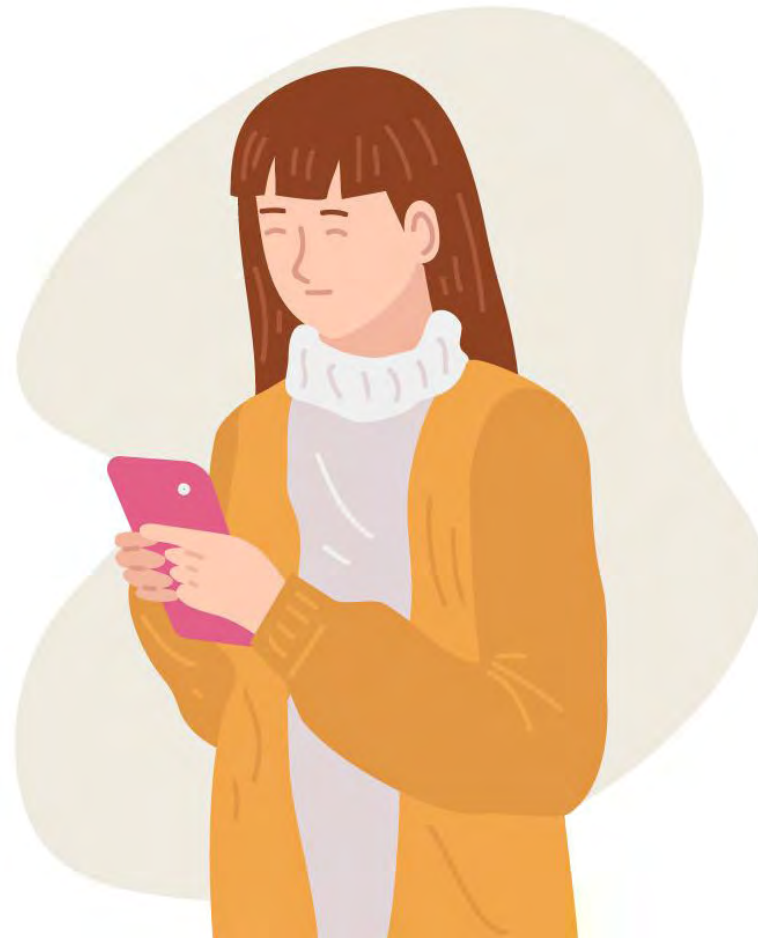

GO ELECTRIC!

If you look around your home, you will likely see all the typical electrical devices and appliances plugged in, turned on and humming right along. Not much thought is usually given to electricity because it tends to always be there when you need it. But what if those things could be used in a way that is even more efficient, all while improving your life and allowing for the electric grid to be operated more effectively? Sounds like a heavy lift, but with the concept of beneficial electrification, it is possible. Here are some ways you can Go Electric!

Electric Vehicles

Consider your vehicle. Most people still operate a gas-powered car or truck for their daily commute to and from work. It becomes routine to fill it with gas, change the oil, conduct maintenance, etc. However, electric vehicles provide another option that offers significant benefits to the owner, their neighbors, and the global community.

The individual benefits include lower costs to operate; more power when accelerating; reduced maintenance requirements; quieter

operation and zero emissions. The individual benefits sound pretty good, but it goes beyond that. With an EV, your neighbor does not have to listen to the motor running and won't smell any fumes. Now take that concept even further. The EV that is plugged in to an electrical outlet to charge becomes part of the electric grid. As more EV's are plugged in for charging, electric utilities, like Sioux Valley Energy, can coordinate the timing for when there is less demand on the system—such as the middle of the night. This shifts electric use to a time when there is very low demand, allowing the grid to operate more efficiently and maximizing the use of power generated from renewable sources. As EVs expand globally, the impact multiplies. This is the concept of beneficial electrification. Sioux Valley Energy offers several incentives for EV owners:

Rate Options to Take Advantage of Off-Peak Reduced Rates (Rates as low as 5.84 cents/kWh)

- Time of Use Rate (TOU): Whole home usage including

- EV charging
 - Vehicle Plug-In Rate: EV charging usage only (submeter installation required)
 - Rebates and Incentives (restrictions apply)
 - \$500 for purchase of new battery electric vehicle (BEV)
 - \$250 for purchase of new plug-in hybrid electric vehicle (PHEV)
 - \$300 for EV-Ready New Home Construction
 - Renewable Energy Credits (RECs) Rebate – Receive one year of free RECs to off-set your total electric usage with renewable energy

Water Heating

Beneficial electrification encompasses more than just EVs. Electric water heaters, such as those sold by Sioux Valley Energy, are efficient and act almost as a “battery” for heating water. The Marathon® and HTP electric water heaters warm the water when electric demand is lower and are able to store hot water for use when the system has more demand on it. Sioux Valley Energy members can purchase water heaters for a discounted

price of \$500 plus applicable tax with participation in the load management program. Lifetime tank/six-year parts warranty for the original purchaser of Marathon or HTP water heaters (some restrictions apply).

Heating and Cooling

Heating and cooling use the largest chunk of your home energy dollars. When you choose electric to heat your home, you know it's clean, reliable, safe – and it can also be very energy efficient. It's tough to beat the efficiency of an electric heat pump that not only cools your home in the summer, but also heats it in the winter.
